All potential volunteers must be interviewed prior to placement. We also require that all volunteers participate in our Training Orientation Program as a part of their work experience. If you agree with our mission and are willing to be interviewed and trained, we encourage you to complete the volunteer application. The information on this form will help us find the most satisfying and appropriate job for you.

Hours scheduled will be coordinated with the shelter staff. As a volunteer, the animals rely on you to show up and spend valuable time with them.
